

**Sewer Separation Project  
Construction Update  
For The Week of October 31<sup>st</sup> – November 5<sup>th</sup>**

## **NOTICE**

**Port Clinton Road (CR 117) will be CLOSED TO ALL THRU TRAFFIC beginning Monday, Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> and will remain closed for 60 days.**

### **Phase II (Areas and Streets south of US Route 20)**

#### **Crew #4**

- Rough grading and filling to continue, weather permitting. This includes filling behind curbs, sidewalks, etc.
- Preparation for road restoration on roads south of US Rt. 20, including Fort Findlay Road, as well as asphalt driveways to continue throughout the week.

### **Phase II**

#### **Crew #1**

- 10/31 through 11/1, storm mainline relocation to occur at 821 Water St.
- 11/1 and 11/2 storm mainline installation to occur on Fort Findlay Rd, west of Lueke Ave.
- Remainder of the week will be pavement preparation on Fort Findlay Rd and other areas.

**Fort Findlay Rd will continue to be closed 6:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Saturday with asphalt placement scheduled for Saturday, 11/5, weather permitting.**

### **Phase III**

- Port Clinton Rd (CR 117) Installation of the sanitary sewer main. **Construction activity to resume on Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup> and through the remainder of the week, including milling in preparation for asphalt restoration scheduled for Saturday, 11/5, weather permitting.**

### **Phase I, II & III**

- Asphalt restoration to continue in all phases as necessary

Sanitary sewer mainline construction will begin again on Lueke Ave south of Fort Findlay Rd sometime during the early week of Nov. 7<sup>th</sup>. At that time, no ingress/egress will be possible for traffic entering or leaving Lueke Ave. Access or egress to residents south of Fort Findlay Rd along or adjacent to Lueke Ave **WILL HAVE TO BE MADE FROM OR TO GRANDE AVE.** This would include police and emergency vehicles, as well as buses.

Please note that all sidewalks will be open in all areas.

**All schedules will be weather permitting**
