

**Sewer Separation Project
Construction Update
For The Week of April 11 through April 15, 2011**

Phase I

Crew #1

- Construction is currently on North St just east of the Maple St intersection.
Monday, April 11 the intersection of Maple and North Sts WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC, including buses and emergency vehicles.
- Construction will continue west on North St and terminate at Lime St.
- Construction will proceed to Lynn and Maple Sts, both north of North St, then continue and be at the Elm and Depot St intersection moving to the west on Depot St toward Lime St.

Crew #2

- Construction is currently on Perry St, immediately south of the Depot St intersection.
On Monday April 11 the intersection of Perry & Depot Sts WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC, including buses and emergency vehicles.
- Sanitary laterals will proceed to be installed on Perry St between First & Depot Sts, due to the pavement crosscuts, this section of pavement will make access impossible between First & Depot Sts. Local residents may be inconvenienced for short periods of time while coming and going to their homes. The contractor will make every attempt to minimize any inconvenience.
- Construction will then proceed to install sanitary laterals with the pavement crosscuts on Walnut St, north of First St. Again, due to the pavement crosscuts the area will not be accessible for short periods of time to residents and/or emergency vehicles.

With regard to traffic, local residents will be able to access their homes, with NO THRU TRAFFIC ALLOWED. Emergency vehicles and buses will be able to access the areas. As before, when working in the various intersections, traffic WILL NOT be able to get through so the traveling public and construction crews can maintain a level of safety.

Phase II

Crew #3

- Construction is currently on College Ave between Cherry & Elm Sts. **It would be anticipated that the intersection of College Ave & Elm St WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC, including buses and emergency vehicles** – either late Monday afternoon and/or Tuesday morning while the crew places the appropriate structures in the intersection.
- Construction will then proceed west on College Ave and terminate approximately 300' west of the intersection.
- Thereafter, Elm St both north and south of College Ave will be under construction.
- Other Streets to be affected during the week will be:
 - South Cherry St
 - The alley north of College Ave between Perry & Cherry Sts.

As before, intersection work will require the denying of access to all traffic. Traffic flow will be available to local residents, buses and emergency vehicles – **NO THRU TRAFFIC WILL BE ALLOWED.**

All schedules will be weather permitting

All sidewalks will be open
