The Village of Woodville has recently completed the new sanitary sewer mainline and lateral installation. This improvement was mandated by the Ohio EPA to improve the sanitary sewer system and to prevent overflows of sewage into the river. The existing, "old", sewer system will be converted to storm water only.

We are informing the property owners of Woodville that the one year countdown will begin, June 15, 2012 to have your property's sanitary service replaced and/or connected, as applicable, into the new sanitary system. June 15, 2013 this time limit will expire.

Only sanitary waste is allowed into the new system. Any storm water should be diverted to the ground if possible or may go into the old combined system sewer. If you have replaced any sanitary sewer lines in the past you are required to prove to the Village that you have plastic pipe and that no storm water is in this line. All residents are required to file a permit signed by the home owner and the contractor performing the service replacement/connection improvements. There is no fee for this permit.

It is our recommendation that you should try to get a minimum of two quotes for your own protection. We have discussed the requirements with various contractors. We have "As Built" drawings available for review to aid in the location of the new mainline and laterals (installed by the Village's contractor) in relation to your property. The Village also requires an inspection by the Village of your new service pipe and connection to the tap into the new system that was provided for your property. Premium backfill is required over the pipe in the sidewalk area as well as a clay dam if stone bedding/backfill is used in the new pipe trench to the house. When beginning your replacement piping please verify you are not connected with, or otherwise sharing a service lateral with, a neighboring property.

You may also be responsible for any necessary removal of existing sidewalk within the right-way in order to connect to the new system. The Village will then be replacing up to 6' of any sidewalk removed within the right-of-way at your point of connection to the new system. We will be keeping a log of these areas and will hire this work out in groupings to receive the best pricing possible.
