

**Sewer Separation Project
Construction Update
For The Week of April 4 through April 8, 2011**

Phase I

Crew #1

- Construction will continue on Elm St north of First St, the crew is between First St and Depot St and will continue North St.
- Construction will then proceed west on North St and will terminate at Lime St.

With regard to traffic, local residents will be able to access their homes, but **NO THRU TRAFFIC** will be allowed. Emergency vehicles and buses will be able to access the areas. However, when work is being done in the intersections, traffic will not be able to get through so as to maintain safety for the traveling public and the construction crews.

Crew #2

- Construction will continue north on Walnut St. The crew is currently between First St and the north end of the street and will continue north to the end of the street.
- Mainline sanitary construction will then proceed to Perry St and then to Cherry St and proceed north of First St. During mainline construction, the streets will be open to emergency vehicles and buses as well as local residents, **EXCEPT** when the contractor is working in the intersections of the cross streets at which time the intersections will be closed to **ALL** traffic.

Phase II

Crew #3

- Construction will continue on Perry St between Erie St and US Rt. 20.
Please Note - The intersection at Perry St and College Ave will closed most of the day on Monday, April 4th during the setting of the manhole structure.
- Construction will proceed north on Perry toward US Rt. 20, west on College Ave and terminate approximately 400' west of Elm St.
- Construction will then proceed on:
 - Elm St – between Erie St. and US Rt. 20
 - Cherry St – between College Ave and US Rt. 20

As before, emergency vehicles and buses as well as local residents will be able to travel thru the construction zone unless the zone is in one of the designated intersections at which time the entire intersection will be **CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC**.

All schedules will be weather permitting

All sidewalks will be open
