

ORDINANCE #10-2009

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR GIFTS OF APPRECIATION, MEMORIAL TRIBUTES, OR FLOWER TRIBUTES.

WHEREAS, it is desirable to promote continued good working relations between the employees of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, and the officials of the Village and to express appreciation for a deed well done or to send flower tributes to those associated with business conducted in the Village; and

WHEREAS, a gift purchased not to exceed \$75.00 on each occasion would be an appropriate means of showing appreciation, gratitude, or sorrow to those associated with the business of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE, SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO, that:

1. The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to expend the necessary funds to pay for these items of appreciation, tributes, or flowers not to exceed \$75.00 on each occasion.
2. Ordinance 5-2000 and any part of any other ordinance conflicting with the above provisions are hereby repealed.
3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
