

ORDINANCE #12-2009

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CODIFIED SECTION 521.15 MANDATING THE
REMOVAL OF ANY ANIMAL EXCRETA BY OWNERS ON PUBLIC
PROPERTY AND/OR PRIVATE PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio wishes to establish legislation for the immediate removal of any excreta deposited by any animal;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that Section 521.15 of the Village of Woodville Codified Ordinances be adopted as follows:

521.15 REMOVAL OF ANIMAL EXCRETA


- (a) No person, being the owner or person in charge of any animal shall fail to immediately remove feces deposited by his animal or animals on property, public or private, not owned or possessed by such person.
- (b) Any person violating any provision of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
