

ORDINANCE #4 - 2012

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF BARBARA J. RUNION AS VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 733.262 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville has previously established the position of Village Fiscal Officer, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Barbara J. Runion as Village Fiscal Officer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby approves the appointment of Barbara J. Runion as Village Fiscal Officer.

Section 2. The salary for the Village Fiscal Officer shall be \$31,200.00 per year.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the Clerk-Treasurer term expires on April 1, 2012, and therefore the Fiscal Officer appointment must be authorized and arranged for immediately. Said Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage by Council provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and signature of the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 4. All formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
