

RESOLUTION #7-2012

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A SOURCE WATER PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE'S WATER SUPPLY

WHEREAS, water is a valuable natural resource that should be protected to the fullest extent; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village and its citizens to protect its water source to provide high quality drinking water to its consumers; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio has supplied drinking water to its residents since 1929; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency requires that all public water systems implement and maintain a Source Water Protection Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE, SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Council encourages and supports the implementation and administration of a Source Water Protection Program for the Village's water supply, to ensure high quality drinking water to all consumers.


SECTION 2. That the Source Water Protection Program shall be reviewed and updated annually to provide for ongoing protection of the source water from potential contamination.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.
