

ORDINANCE #6-2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH JOHN DEERE COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A 2014 JOHN DEERE 2025R TRACTOR WITH MOWER DECK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase a 2014 John Deere riding mower for the Village of Woodville from John Deere Company, and

WHEREAS, the Village currently owns a 2010 John Deere X740 riding mower which is no longer needed by the Village, and

WHEREAS, the John Deere Company will accept as trade in, the Village of Woodville's 2010 John Deere X740 riding mower;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Keith Kruse as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute an agreement to purchase from the John Deere Company, Cary, NC a 2014 John Deere 2025R Tractor with a mower deck for the Village of Woodville, and to allow for trade in of \$7,750.00, to depreciate the cost of the 2014 John Deere, a 2010 John Deere X740 riding mower for a total cost difference not to exceed \$12,473.22.



This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase the 2014 John Deere riding mower to provide necessary lawn maintenance services for the Village of Woodville.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
