ORDINANCE #10-2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BAUMANN AUTO GROUP GENOA, LLC FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A 2016 FORD EXPLORER AND A 2016 FORD EXPEDITION FOR THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase a 2016 Ford Explorer and a 2016 Ford Expedition for the Village of Woodville's Police Department from the Baumann Auto Group Genoa, LLC, and

WHEREAS, the Village currently owns a 2011 Dodge Charger and a 2012 Ford Expedition vehicles which are no longer needed by the village, and

WHEREAS, the Baumann Auto Group Genoa, LLC. will accept as trade in, the Village of Woodville's 2011 Dodge Charger and a 2012 Ford Expedition vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Keith Kruse, as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute an agreement to purchase from Baumann Auto Group Genoa, LLC a 2016 Ford Explorer in the amount of \$20,000.00 after allowable trade in, and a 2016 Ford Expedition in the amount of \$17,225.00 after allowable trade in.

Section 2. Tax-Exempt Leasing Corp will provide financing to the Village with a three year purchase lease agreement.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase the police vehicles to provide necessary public safety services for the Village of Woodville.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
