

VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE INCOME TAX FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. As of **JULY 1, 2026**, The Village of Woodville has passed a local income tax at a 1% rate in accordance with Ordinance 1-2026.
2. The Village of Woodville **does not** allow a credit for other municipalities paid.
3. Under the taxable vs nontaxable income there is a list that covers the majority of all taxable and nontaxable items. Please consult with your tax advisor or call the Village of Woodville for any additional questions.
4. The due date of the Village of Woodville income tax return is generally due on April 15th or on the date the Internal Revenue Service return is due.
5. If an extension is filed for your business or personal tax return, please supply the extension form with your Village of Woodville return, this due date is generally on October 15th or on the date the Internal Revenue Service return is due.
6. When remitting your Woodville income tax return, attach all income sources to your tax return such as W-2's, scheduled income such as Schedule C's, F's, E's, K-1 income, and any other source document. Also attach the Federal 1040 and page one of the

8. Please read your W-2 correctly for the correct wages for Village purposes, Medicare wages (box 5) of the W-2 is what is generally what is taxable.
9. An individual under the age of 18 in an entire tax year is not required to pay the local income tax and if they have, they will need to file a Village of Woodville return and request a refund, providing a copy of a driver's license or identification card to show their birthday.
10. A college student not living at home but claimed as a dependent on a parent(s) return is considered domiciled in the Village of Woodville and must pay Village taxes.
11. The Village does not allow offsetting W-2 income with business or rental losses; Business and rental losses can be carried forward for five years.
