Administration: Village Administrator Tom Brickley, Village Solicitor Jenny Kuhlman, Chief Steve Gilkerson. Absent: Council Member Joe Riffle and Fiscal Officer Barb Runion. Audience: Linda Knudsen

Mayor Tracy called the meeting to order and led the Pledge to the Flag.

Minutes of the Finance Committee and Regular Council meetings on July 28, 2025 were approved as presented.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION – Linda suggested being made aware when those taking care of plants communicated when they were on vacation. South side of 20 looks great, north side are dead. (Planters at intersection at Walnut)


