Village of Woodville Update on COVID-19 To ensure both the safety of the Village employees and the residents of Woodville, Mayor Tracy has issued the following statement:

Like many of you, we have spent this week receiving the news and announcements regarding the Coronavirus and COVID-19 situation facing our communities, the state, and the nation. The simple reality is that we are all facing significant changes to the way the government, educational institutions, businesses, and the entertainment industry will be conducting operations in the short and long-term. The COVID-19 situation and the challenges that we all face right now will not change the level of service we provide to our residents though, admittedly, it may change the manner in which we provide it.

We plan, at this time, to keep the Municipal Building-530 Lime St. open with limited access to the entire building in order to heed the Governor's advice regarding social distancing and other spread-related concerns.

Council meetings will continue to meet on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month at 7:00pm, and will be open to the public.

Utility payments will be accepted by mail, online, or by dropping off payments in the lock boxes located at The Town Hall/Police Department lobby – 219 W. Main St., outside the Municipal building front door, or during business hours inside the lobby at the Municipal Building.
